Hawaii House of Representatives, four members of the Senate, the Republican Lieutenant
Governor and the Chair of the Democratic Party of Hawaii to discuss our liability reform and
scope of practice concerns; and

Whereas, After years of fighting crash course psychologists prescribing bills in Committee, since this meeting of the AMA with Hawaii's political leaders, not a single such measure has yet been introduced in Hawaii; and
